The following candidates are eligible for admission to the basic doctoral program:

- Holders of a bachelor's and master's degree (only in the field of law) or a diploma of higher education in a relevant specialty;
 - Graduates of the Academy's master's program;
- Graduates of the master's programs of the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Higher School of Strategic Analysis and Forecasting of the Republic of Uzbekistan, who hold a bachelor's degree in law;
- Candidates who have obtained scientific results that can form the basis of a dissertation research for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in legal sciences, including at least one article published in scientific journals and at least two conference thesis's included in scientific collections of relevant fields;
- Candidates with at least three years of work experience related to the chosen research topic;
- Candidates with a national or internationally recognized certificate confirming their foreign language proficiency.

Applicants for the basic doctoral program must submit the following documents to the Academy:

- Application form;
- Short biographical information (CV);
- Copy of an identity document (passport or ID card);
- A duly certified copy of the employment record book;
- Copy of a bachelor's and master's diploma from a higher education institution or a diploma of higher education in a relevant specialty;
- Copy of a national or internationally recognized language proficiency certificate;
 - List of published scientific works and their copies.

The following candidates are eligible for admission to the doctoral program:

- Holders of a Candidate of Sciences degree in law or a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree in legal sciences, or an equivalent scientific degree obtained in foreign countries;
- Holders of a Candidate of Sciences or PhD degree in legal sciences (or an equivalent degree) who have achieved significant scientific results, including at least three articles published in scientific journals that may serve as the basis for a dissertation for the Doctor of Science (DSc) degree, as well as at least two conference theses published in scientific and practical conference proceedings, seminars, or collections of scientific works in relevant fields.

Applicants for the doctoral program must submit the following documents to the Academy:

- Application form;
- Short biographical information (CV);
- Copy of an identity document (passport or ID card);
- A duly certified copy of the employment record book;
- Copy of a diploma confirming higher education, Candidate of Sciences, or PhD degree in legal sciences (or an equivalent degree obtained in foreign countries);
- A scientific report on the research topic and a detailed draft of the doctoral dissertation plan for obtaining the Doctor of Science (DSc) degree;
 - List of published scientific works and their copies.
