Scientific articles and abstracts for the conference proceedings are accepted in Uzbek, English, or Russian languages until **April 10, 2025, via Telegram at the number: 94 272-57-77.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS AND ABSTRACTS:

1. Materials are accepted only as attached files (abstracts/articles) via the Telegram messenger;
2. The text must be logically coherent, without repetitions, the presented ideas should be clear, concise, and based on scientific discussions;
3. The provided information must be reliable and accurate.;
4. Along with the article title, a brief abstract and keywords must be included in Uzbek, Russian, and English;
5. The main content must be written in one of the following languages: Uzbek, Russian, or English;
6. The text must be typed on a computer using “Microsoft Word”, in “Cambria” font, size 14, with 1.0 line spacing, and submitted as an electronic copy. The left margin should be 3 cm, the right margin 1.5 cm, and the top and bottom margins 2 cm each;
7. The article must include scientific discussion and quotations. Quotations should be written in font size 12 with 1.0 line spacing (footnotes for citations should be placed at the bottom of the respective page);
8. The total length of the article should be 6 to 10 pages, while the abstract should be 3-4 pages long;
9. The first page of the article must include the author's full name, academic degree and title, place of work and position, home and work addresses, and phone numbers;
10. If the author does not hold an academic degree (PhD), the article must be reviewed by a leading scientist or specialist in the relevant field, or by the head of the institution where the author or researcher works, or its structural subdivision (department).

The Organizing committee assumes responsibility for sorting the abstracts and articles, as well as their electronic publication..

Submissions will be accepted based on the strict requirements outlined above.
