The Law enforcement academy of the Republic of Uzbekistan is planning to hold an international scientific-practical conference on the topic “Modern challenges and threats in the field of law enforcement in the era of digital transformation” on June 19–20 of this year. Within the framework of the conference, a collection of conference materials will be published based on the presentations and theses of leading national and international experts. In this regard, scientific articles and theses related to the topic should be submitted in Uzbek, English, or Russian by **July 15, 2025** to the following email addresses: shayzakovshodiyor@gmail.com and info@proacademy.uz

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING ARTICLES AND THESES:

1. The article should include a systematic analysis on one of the conference topics and contain clear, original theoretical and practical proposals;
2. The text must be logically structured, free of repetition, and the arguments should be clear, concise, and based on scientific discussion and reasoning;
3. All information provided must be reliable and accurate;
4. Along with the article title, a short abstract and keywords must be provided in Uzbek, Russian, and English;
5. The text should be submitted in one of the following languages: Uzbek, Russian, or English;
6. The text must be typed in Microsoft Word using the Times New Roman font, size 14, with 1.5 line spacing, and submitted in electronic format. Page margins should be: 3 cm on the left, 1.5 cm on the right, 2 cm at the top and bottom;
7. The article should include scientific discussion and citations. Citations must be written in font size 12 with 1.0 line spacing, and placed as footnotes at the bottom of the relevant page;
8. The article should be between 6 to 10 pages, and theses should be 3–4 pages in length;
9. The first page of the article must include the author's full name, academic degree and title, place of work and position, residential and work address, and contact phone numbers;
10. If the author does not hold an academic degree (e.g., PhD), the article must be accompanied by a peer review (recommendation) from a leading scholar or expert in the field, or from the head of the department or relevant structural unit of the institution where the author or researcher is affiliated, confirming the article's suitability for publication in the collection.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select the submitted theses and articles and to publish them in electronic format.

Materials will be accepted strictly in accordance with the requirements set out in this letter.

It is planned that scientific articles (excluding presentation theses) written in foreign languages, consisting of no less than 10 pages and reviewed by leading international scholars (the review must be attached), will be considered equivalent to scientific articles published in foreign academic journals included in the list of recommended publications for disseminating the main scientific results of dissertations.

NOTE: Articles are accepted only in electronic form. The article title must indicate to which section of the conference the article belongs. Materials that do not meet the above requirements will not be accepted for publication and will not be returned to the author.
