

**DECREE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN
ON THE INTRODUCTION OF A QUALITATIVELY NEW SYSTEM FOR TRAINING
QUALIFIED PERSONNEL IN THE FIELD OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION**

In our country, fully realizing the noble idea of “For Human Dignity” in investigative activities, organizing the timely detection of crimes, and improving the activities of investigative bodies on the basis of ensuring the rule of law and the inevitability of punishment for committed acts is considered one of the important tasks.

In this regard, it is required to fundamentally increase the effectiveness of reforms being implemented in the field, as well as the system of training and retraining highly qualified specialists in the field of investigation who meet modern requirements.

Under the conditions of New Uzbekistan, in order to bring the practice of training and retraining qualified personnel in the field of criminal investigation to a qualitatively new level, widely introduce advanced international standards and modern information technologies in this direction, and meet the demand of law enforcement agencies for highly qualified personnel:

1. The following proposals of the Prosecutor General’s Office, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the State Security Service, the National Guard, the State Customs Committee, and the Ministry of Justice shall be approved:

Establishment of the Law Enforcement Academy of the Republic of Uzbekistan (hereinafter — the Academy) on the basis of the Academy of the Prosecutor General’s Office, and introduction of a continuous education system aimed at training personnel in the field of criminal investigation based on a unified approach closely linked with practice;

Abolishment of the Specialized Branch of Tashkent State University of Law (hereinafter — the Specialized Branch) and transfer of its staff units, educational and material-technical base to the Academy.

2. The following shall be defined as the main areas of activity of the Academy:

Deep targeted basic training of specialists in criminal investigation through the introduction of an effective system for developing high moral, psychological, analytical, and professional qualities harmonized with a culture of unconditional respect for human rights and freedoms;

Training, retraining, and advanced training of personnel in investigative and other law enforcement activities based on programs aimed at developing special professional skills and conveying the essence of judicial-legal reforms;

Establishing a system for improving qualifications and retraining employees of state bodies and other organizations in combating corruption and money laundering based on special training programs;

Introducing interactive teaching methods into the educational process aimed at developing independent case-handling skills based on effective determination of investigation methodology and tactics;

Organizing the educational process based on modern forms of teaching, pedagogical and information technologies, ensuring a close link between theoretical training and law enforcement practice, including through distance learning;

Creating a unified system for training, retraining, and advanced training aimed at forming and strengthening knowledge, skills, systemic analysis, critical thinking, and a sense of justice and responsibility among prosecutors;

Training highly qualified scientific and pedagogical personnel and conducting comprehensive scientific research on pressing issues of law enforcement activities on a systematic basis, including through attracting national and international grants;

Analyzing crimes by type based on the study of pre-investigation materials and criminal cases, and providing methodological and advisory support for crime prevention and combating crime;

Ensuring continuous international cooperation in joint scientific research, exchange of advanced pedagogical experience, and involvement of qualified specialists from leading foreign educational and research institutions in the educational process.

3. The Coordination and Supervisory Board of the Academy shall be established in accordance with Appendix 1. It shall assist the Academy in key areas such as determining educational needs, organizing internships and employment, developing cooperation, and attracting financial resources.

4. It shall be established that:

The Academy is a specialized higher educational and research institution within the structure of the Prosecutor General's Office with the status of a legal entity;

The Academy is headed by a director appointed and dismissed by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

The Academy is the legal successor of the Academy of the Prosecutor General's Office;

At least 30% of the staff of specialized investigative departments shall consist of highly qualified practitioners from investigative bodies;

Employees shall be granted remuneration and benefits equivalent to those of relevant state employees.

5. Starting from the 2023/2024 academic year, a full-fledged two-stage higher education system (Bachelor's and Master's degrees) shall be introduced in investigative and other law enforcement fields, including:

Full-time bachelor's education focused on specialized legal training and internships;

Admission to master's programs primarily from among current employees of authorized state bodies;

Admission through psychological selection, written exams, and tests;

Duration: 3 years for Bachelor's and 1 year for Master's;

Annual quotas: up to 250 students for Bachelor's and up to 50 for Master's programs.

Additional provisions include:

Education on a state grant and contract basis;

No special admission privileges;

Mandatory service for graduates funded by state grants;

Free education and salary retention for certain categories of employees.

6. It shall be established that:

Employees of authorized state bodies who achieve high results in their studies shall, upon graduation from the Academy's Master's program in investigative activities, as a rule, be appointed to positions higher than those previously held;

The period of study at the Academy shall be counted toward the total length of service (including military service), granting the right to pension, rank (grade), and long-service benefits, with one year of study equated to one year of service.

7. A mandatory procedure for professional retraining and advanced training shall be introduced for employees of authorized state bodies at the Academy under the following programs:

For employees newly recruited into authorized state bodies and appointed to positions of inquiry officer or investigator, as well as those newly recruited into prosecutor's offices — professional retraining courses in the form of initial specialization with a duration of not less than 576 hours;

For personnel included in the reserve for managerial positions in prosecutor's offices — professional retraining courses for managerial staff with a duration of not less than 576 hours;

For employees of authorized state bodies intended for appointment to inquiry officer or investigator positions — professional retraining courses with a duration of not less than 288 hours;

For employees of inquiry and investigation units of authorized state bodies, as well as all levels of prosecutor's offices (at least once every three years) — advanced training courses with a duration of not less than 144 hours.

It shall be established that:

Admission to retraining courses shall be carried out based on recommendations from heads of authorized state bodies;

Employees appointed to investigative positions or newly recruited into prosecutor's offices shall complete the relevant courses within six months from the date of appointment;

This requirement shall not apply to graduates of the Academy or graduates of the Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in the specialty "Investigative Activity";

During retraining and advanced training, employees shall retain their salaries (monetary allowances) in accordance with established procedures.

8. The following shall be approved:

Structural-logical scheme of the unified system of continuous training of personnel in the field of criminal investigation (Appendix 2);

Structure of the Law Enforcement Academy of the Republic of Uzbekistan (Appendix 3);

“Roadmap” for effective organization of the Academy’s activities (Appendix 4).

9. The following rights shall be granted:
a) To the Supervisory Board — to submit proposals for increasing admission quotas to Bachelor’s and Master’s programs in investigative activities based on the needs of authorized state bodies;

b) To the Prosecutor General:

To organize the educational process in the Academy in evening, part-time, and distance formats for specialties other than investigative activity;

To make changes to the Academy’s structure within staffing limits and wage fund;

To introduce additional staff funded through paid services and tuition fees;

To set additional admission quotas on a differentiated contract basis beyond established parameters;

c) To the Academy:

To independently develop and approve qualification requirements, curricula, and programs based on the needs of authorized state bodies;

To provide paid services in scientific, educational, publishing, printing, and other activities not prohibited by law;

To engage specialists (consultants, lecturers, teachers, etc.) on hourly or long-term contracts and determine remuneration from extra-budgetary funds based on labor market conditions;

d) To the Head of the Academy:

To award additional individual scholarships to talented Bachelor’s students from extra-budgetary funds;

To conclude agreements and memoranda with leading foreign educational and research institutions;

To organize training, retraining, and advanced training courses for foreign specialists within international cooperation frameworks.

10. The sources of funding for the Academy shall include:

State Budget funds of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

Tuition fees from contract-based education;

Income from paid services and placement of temporarily free funds in bank deposits;

Extra-budgetary funds allocated by state bodies represented in the Supervisory Board;

National and international grants, as well as other sources not prohibited by law.

A limit shall be set for the Academy to maintain six service vehicles (including five assigned vehicles) and two buses.

11. It shall be established that:

Students of the abolished Specialized Branch shall continue their education at the Academy under previously established conditions until completion;

Diplomas issued by foreign educational institutions under joint programs shall be recognized without additional procedures;

A Master's diploma of the Academy shall be equivalent to diplomas of corresponding programs in military and law enforcement education institutions;

Tuition fees shall be determined annually by the Supervisory Board;

Employees of the abolished branch shall be employed at the Academy under fixed-term contracts;

Funding in 2022 shall be within allocated budgets, and from 2023 onward — included in state budget parameters.

12. The Tashkent city administration shall:

Ensure completion and commissioning of the Academy's facilities by the end of the 2023/2024 academic year;

Provide temporary buildings, dormitories, and classrooms for students.

13. The Ministry of Internal Affairs shall:

Stop admission to Bachelor's programs in "Investigative Activity" at its Academy;

Transfer educational resources to the Academy;

Increase admission quotas in other relevant specialties.

14. The Presidential Advisor shall, within two months, develop a concept for improving the ideological, moral, and intellectual capacity of prosecutors.

15. The Prosecutor General's Office shall, within three months:

Organize transfer of property and resources;

Submit proposals for new admission procedures;

Propose legislative amendments.

16. The Ministry of Economic Development shall include funding proposals for the Academy's campus in national development programs.

17. Amendments shall be made to certain presidential acts.

18. Certain provisions of the Presidential Resolution No. PQ-4166 dated February 7, 2019 shall be declared invalid.

19. Responsibility for implementation of this Decree shall be assigned to the Prosecutor General N.T. Yuldoshev. Oversight and coordination shall be carried out by the Prime Minister A.N. Aripov and the Deputy Advisor to the President D.B. Kadirov.

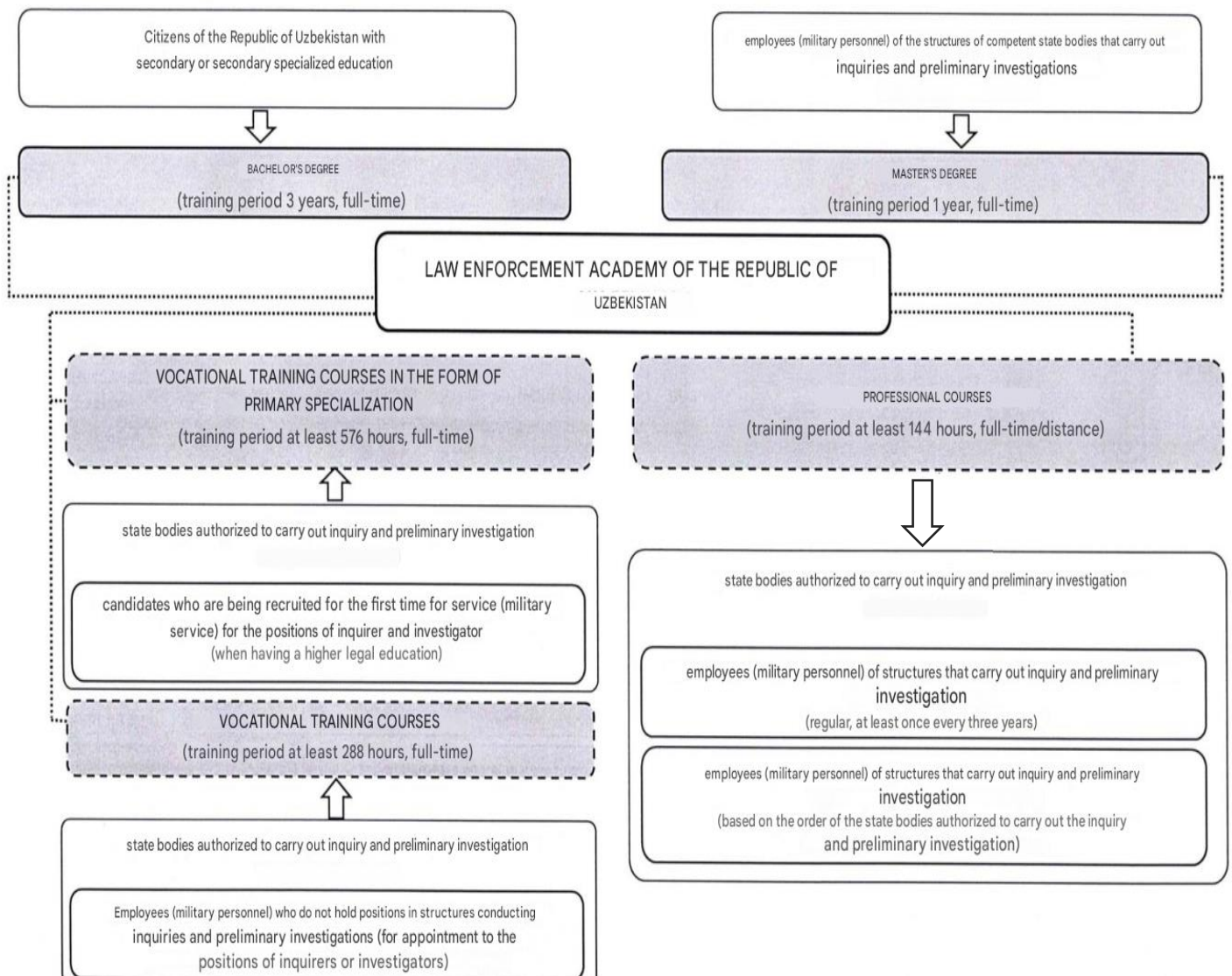

Structural and Logical Scheme of the Unified Continuous Training System for Personnel in the Field of Criminal Investigation

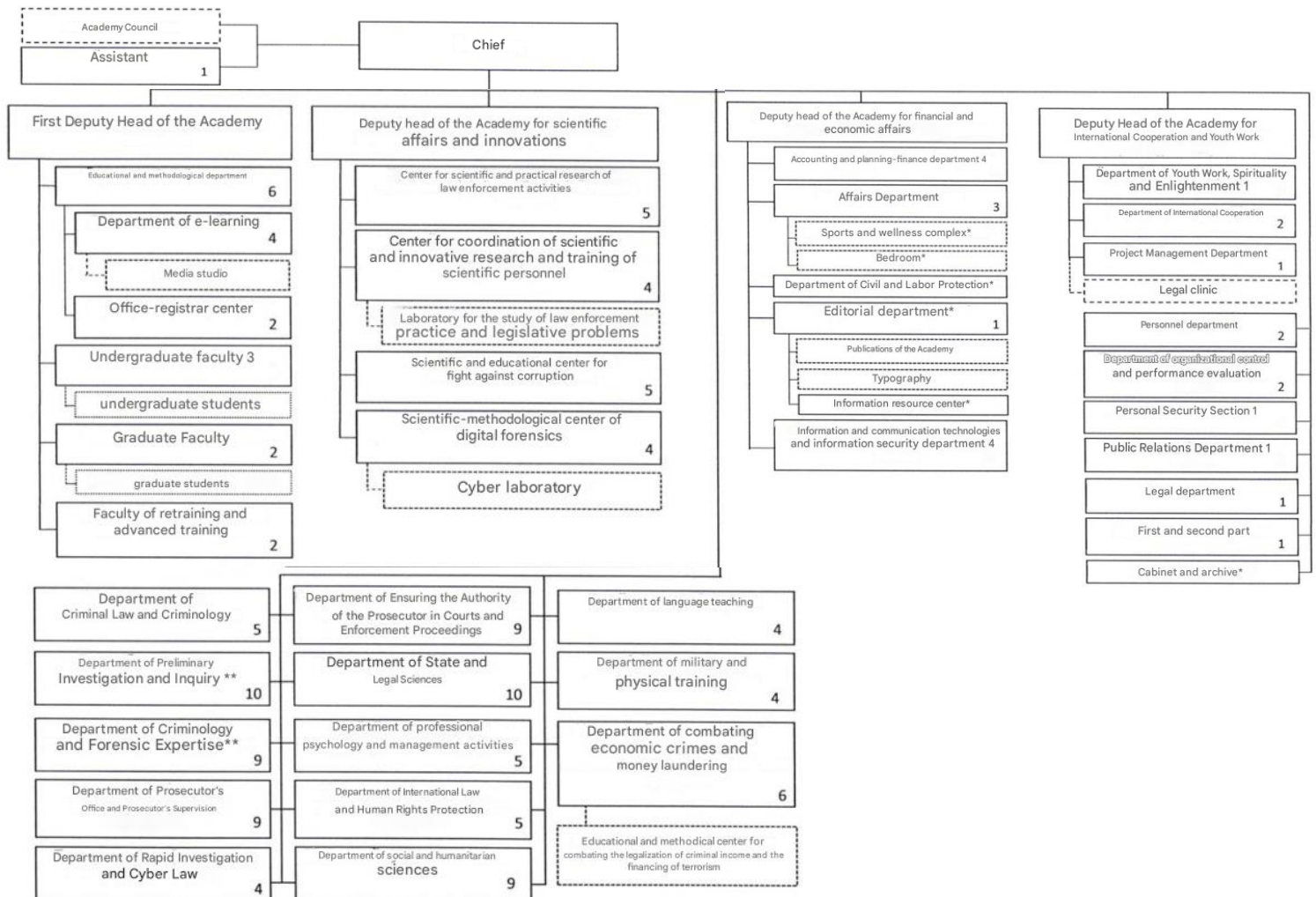

In cases where two or more measures are combined, the final deadline for these issues shall be considered the latest deadline set for the implementation of the combined measures. During the process of drafting normative-legal acts, other matters corresponding to the content of the measures indicated in the "Roadmap" may also be taken into account.

Amendments and additions being made to certain documents of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan

1. In the Decree No. PF-5438 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated May 8, 2018, "On measures to radically improve the system for training, retraining, and professional development of personnel of the prosecutor's offices":

a) Clauses 1 and 7 shall be considered null and void;

b) The first sentence of Clause 2 shall be revised as follows:
"2. The following shall be defined as the main tasks and directions of activity of the Academy of Law Enforcement of the Republic of Uzbekistan (hereinafter – the Academy) in the field of training, retraining, and professional development of personnel of the prosecutor's offices";

c) In Clause 3:

In subclause "a", the phrase "candidates for occupying positions in the bodies" shall be replaced with "employees entering service in the bodies for the first time";

Subclause "v" shall be revised as follows:
"Employees entering service in the prosecutor's offices for the first time shall undergo professional retraining provided for in the second sentence of subclause 'a' of Clause 3 immediately upon being appointed to the position of a prosecutor's junior officer."

d) The second sentence of Clause 4 shall be deleted;

e) Clause 5 shall be revised as follows:
"5. The Prosecutor General of the Republic of Uzbekistan shall be granted the right to organize the educational process in the field of training, retraining, and professional development of personnel of the prosecutor's offices in the form of full-time, evening, part-time, and distance learning."

f) In Clause 6:

The third and eighth sentences shall be deleted;

The fourth through seventh sentences shall be considered the third through sixth sentences, respectively;

g) Clause 8 shall be revised as follows:
"8. The Academy shall be permitted to involve highly qualified specialists and experts from leading educational institutions, research institutes, state bodies, and other organizations, including foreign countries, in the educational process on a contractual basis."

2. The text of Appendix 1 to the Decree No. PF-5929 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated January 30, 2020, “On approval of the composition of the staff of the Prosecutor General’s Office of the Republic of Uzbekistan”, shall be revised as follows:

3. In the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated June 29, 2020, No. PF-6013, “On additional measures to improve the system of combating corruption in the Republic of Uzbekistan”:

a) In paragraph 7, sixth subparagraph, the words “at the Academy of the Prosecutor General’s Office” shall be replaced with “at the Law Enforcement Academy”.

b) In the annex, item 31 shall be amended as follows: “31. By position — Head of the Law Enforcement Academy of the Republic of Uzbekistan”.

4. In the Regulation on Service in the Prosecutor's Office Bodies and Institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan, approved by the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 12, 2013, No. PQ-2036, Russian text:

a) In paragraphs 18 and 62, the words "Academy of the Prosecutor General's Office" shall be replaced with "Law Enforcement Academy".

b) In paragraph 27:

In the sixth subparagraph, after "Deputy heads", insert "Professors and heads of structural divisions."

In the seventh subparagraph, the words "Heads of departments, heads of divisions, and heads of sectors" shall be replaced with "Assistant head, associate professors, senior lecturers, and senior prosecutors of structural divisions".

In the eighth subparagraph, the words "Research staff and lecturers" shall be replaced with "Lecturers and prosecutors of structural divisions".

c) In paragraph 35, first subparagraph, the words "Academy of the Prosecutor General's Office" shall be replaced with "Law Enforcement Academy".

d) In paragraph 81², fifth subparagraph, the text shall be amended as follows:

(Note: The new wording of paragraph 81², fifth subparagraph, was not provided in your text.)

"Application to employees specified in paragraph 81¹ of this Regulation of benefits, measures of material and social protection, other material advantages, as well as payment of allowances to the official salary and an increased tariff coefficient established for employees of the prosecutor's office bodies, shall be carried out at the expense of the republican or local budgets".

5. The Russian-language text of Appendix 1 to the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated November 13, 2013, No. PQ-2065, "On measures to strengthen material incentives and social protection of employees of the prosecutor's office bodies of the Republic of Uzbekistan", shall be set out in the following wording:

Note: Additional funds required to cover the above-established tariff coefficient, starting from January 1, 2020, shall be provided from the State Budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan. At the same time, by way of exception, regardless of the prohibition established by law, it is permitted to pay additional material incentives to the officials specified in this annex from the off-budget funds of the prosecution authorities, applying the established tariff coefficient rates.

6. In the Presidential Decree No. PQ-2142 of March 5, 2014, which approved the list of officials whose foreign business trips require special coordination with the relevant units of the Administration of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in Section 3, "Advisory Units on Coordination of Law Enforcement and Supervisory Activities", the words "Academy of the Prosecutor General's Office" shall be replaced with "Law Enforcement Academy".

7. In the Presidential Decree No. PQ-4210 of February 25, 2019, "On measures to improve the position of the Republic of Uzbekistan in international rankings and indexes", in the annex, items 6 and 14 under the column "Responsible Research Institutes," the words "Academy of the Prosecutor General's Office" shall be replaced with "Law Enforcement Academy".
