

The followings are accepted for basic doctoral studies:

- Those who have a bachelor's and master's degree in the field of law or a diploma of higher education (specialization);
- Scientific results that can make up the volume of a dissertation for obtaining the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in legal sciences, including materials for publication in scientific journals, at least one article and the production of relevant scientific works attached to the theses of information that can be collected by no less than two scientific works;
- at least three years of work experience related to a topic recognized for scientific research;
- National or relevant certificate of foreign language proficiency.
